Curious about mindfulness meditation? Feeling extra stressed these days?

If either of those sounds like you, join us for Koru, a 4-week mindfulness meditation class. Koru is designed to be an introduction to the practice of mindfulness and will give participants the opportunity to learn several skills, including meditation, for managing stress and enriching their lives.

Koru's randomized, controlled trial shows the following results:

- Students reported feeling more calm
- Students improved their mindfulness
- Students felt more rested
- Students had greater self-compassion

This course will run from 11:00 am – 12:15 pm on Wednesdays starting December 9 (December 9, 16, 23, and January 6). This course will be held on Zoom, so no worries if you are traveling – you can join us from anywhere! This course is open to all members of the GC community, students, faculty, and staff.
