

In this six-week Young Scientists Academy (YSA) program, academically motivated rising seniors conduct research under the guidance of a Georgia College faculty member and undergraduate mentors. These YSA Internship students tackle an individual research project and acquire valuable technical and analytical skills, culminating in data analysis and a YSA poster symposium. In some cases, YSA interns will submit their work to national science conferences like the American Chemical Society's National Conference.

Throughout the six weeks of the program, students participate in weekly workshops with the YSA Director who provides insight into the scientific process, research ethics, how to read a research paper, how to make a poster, and how to network in the science and engineering fields. There are also sessions on college admission strategies and programs.

This summer we have seven Young Scientists Academy interns conducting research. Come see them present their research findings in this special symposium. Light refreshments will be served afterwards in the Kilpatrick Atrium.

As a former adjunct faculty member and lecturer at Yale University, she participated in multidisciplinary research focused on social emotional neurodevelopment. She is a co-developer of the Social Emotional Engagement – Knowledge and Skills (SEE-KS) professional learning approach, which provides freely accessible tools for measuring learner engagement and enhancing engagement in natural contexts. She lectures internationally and provides consultation to education, healthcare and child welfare systems to support social and emotional engagement, learning and development in universal settings.
