

Happy New Year! Looking for a fun and rewarding way to give back to your community this year? Through the Georgia College & State University Thirst for Knowledge Program, you can become Georgia Adopt-a-Stream certified in Chemical Monitoring Wednesday, Jan. 10 from 9 a.m. until 12 p.m. (Register here: https://givepul.se/m47b90). Training certification is valid for one year.



The Chemical Monitoring Workshop is designed to teach volunteers about basic stream water chemistry and how to conduct various chemical tests using hand-held field equipment. The basic set of tests include dissolved oxygen, conductivity, pH and temperature. Volunteers who collect data within 10% accuracy and pass the written test with a score of 80% or better will be certified to conduct chemical monitoring.

Students can satisfy CbEL requirements for GC Journeys through the GCSU Thirst for Knowledge Program, and the trainings are open to all. Another Chemical Training will be offered March 15. Additional trainings available upon request.

Are you an undergraduate student enrolled in the arts, humanities, social sciences and physical sciences? Do you like to write? Then, apply your imagination and writing skills by entering the Margaret Harvin Wilson Writing Award contest. Finalists will receive a cash award.

Enter in these categories:

- poetry may submit up to three poems, maximum five pages
- drama one-act play, one submission, maximum 20 pages
- short story typed and double-spaced, one submission, maximum
  20 pages

There will be two separate contests: One for first-year or sophomore students and one for junior or senior students.

This award was established in memory of Margaret Harvin Wilson, '34, who was born Nov. 11, 1913, in Chattanooga, Tennessee. After her parents divorced, her mother remarried and moved to Grovetown, Georgia, in 1923. No one in the family had attended college, but Margaret was determined because "high school was not enough."

Fortunately, her father provided a small trust (\$1,250), and Margaret enrolled in Georgia State College for Women, which is now Georgia College, and finished in three years (English major, French minor). Margaret waited tables in the dining hall in exchange for discounted tuition and lived in a "free dormitory."

When she was a senior, a teacher encouraged her to enter a short story contest in the English department. Winning first prize in 1933 for "Sympathy Speaks" gave her great confidence for her subsequent career as a teacher.

Margaret married Leland Wilson in 1938 and enjoyed a wonderful and interesting life with him in academe. Their three daughters, inspired by the importance of education in their parents' lives, pursued careers in medicine, law and higher education.



Her college experience was critical to Margaret's intellectual growth, development and in stimulating her desire to explore the world beyond her hometown.

The Transeuntis Mundi Project proposes to capture the sound and visual memory of peoples, cultural expressions and places to artistically tell the story of the millennial passerbys that have been crossing the world. It currently portrays the diversity of four countries from four continents and generates a poetical/documental archive of human cultural heritage.

The expression Transeuntis Mundi comes from Latin, the lingua franca of the expansion of Western Culture. It personifies the human being who has been taking the adventure to discover and explore the world.

Its methodology employs Walkscapes recordings with immersive 360° technology. From this archive, it starts a process of transmedial composition: creation of virtual reality works, videos, photographs, sound art, musical compositions and performance, with the aim to immerse the observer/participant into an experience beyond their space and time. In short, it's a combination of knowledge, innovation and poetics supported by the processes of artistic research and mediated by transmedial technology.

Workshop activities will assume that attendees have access to ChatGPT and Microsoft Word, Google Docs or similar during the talk. Attendees can create a free ChatGPT account in advance at <u>https://chat.openai.com/</u>.

This hands-on workshop will introduce educators to the practical use of ChatGPT for writing instruction. The workshop will have a particular focus on how ChatGPT and similar tools can support



teaching (1) specific writing genres, (2) research literacy and (3) critical technology appraisal. Attendees who wish to participate in the hands-on portion of the workshop should create a free ChatGPT account and bring a laptop.

Biography: S. Scott Graham is an associate professor in the Department of Rhetoric & Writing and the associate director for Health, Humanities and Medicine at the Humanities Institute at The University of Texas at Austin. His research is devoted to exploring the ethical use of artificial intelligence in scientific and medical writing, and he teaches classes on AI, writing and persuasion in a variety of contexts. His latest book is The Doctor & The Algorithm (Oxford University Press), and his recent essays on AI have appeared in Inside Higher Education, Stat News and Composition Studies.

This workshop is hosted by the Digital Humanities Collaborative and the departments of Art, History & Geography and World Languages & Cultures, and co-organized by the Center for Teaching & Learning and the Writing Center.

# AI Lab at GCSU to educate students, faculty and Middle Georgia

Information Systems & Computer Science, Department of : Wednesday January 24, 2024

Georgia College & State University is introducing the AI Lab at the J. Whitney Bunting College of Business & Technology. It will prepare students and the public to use this developing technology.

The AI Lab will be a resource for the Central Georgia community with workshops on artificial intelligence, faculty-led research and projects for employers in the area. The lab is currently housed on the fourth floor of Atkinson Hall.

"The emerging technologies inherent to AI will have a fundamental impact on the workplace," said Georgia College Provost and Vice President of Academic Affairs Dr. Costas Spirou.

"This new lab is an excellent example of the innovative and entrepreneurial spirit central to a public liberal arts education," Spirou said, "as we adapt and seek out new ways to ensure our students are prepared for the opportunities, challenges and possibilities ahead."

Led by Dr. Jeannie Pridmore, department chair of Information Systems and Computer Science, and directed by Dr. Ward Risvold, lecturer of business communications, the AI Lab will centralize Georgia College's efforts to navigate changes brought by the technology.

In his 2018 Strategy on New Technologies report, Secretary-General of the United Nations António Guterres said technologies like automation, artificial intelligence and robotics "hold incredible promise for human welfare."

Students will have access to workshops and guidance, allowing them to master the tools of artificial intelligence. It will be a place for faculty too, where they take part in interdisciplinary research and find ways to integrate AI into their teaching.

The School of Continuing and Professional Studies at Georgia College will also leverage its outreach to lead the charge in area schools, helping students understand AI tools. They'll provide courses for students, community members and local businesses.

"We're at a crossroads," Risvold said. "Technologically speaking, this is an industrial revolution of a different kind. Our students, all of them, have to be prepared to be more effective and productive, being able to use AI."

The AI Lab's first event is 5:30 to 7 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 7, in the Arts & Sciences Auditorium. The speaker will be Greg Lane, retired senior director for the CIA and one of the





lab's preliminary advisory board members. He will discuss the use of AI and what skill sets employers need in relation to AI.

"The faculty and I are proud of our shared culture of curricula innovation and our work to reimagine teaching, learning and scholarly pursuits," said Dr. Micheal Stratton, dean of the College of Business and Technology.

"Employers and citizens demand our students at a public liberal arts university are agile and highly competent with respect to technology," Stratton said. "It is critical that our students have a competitive advantage as they pursue employment opportunities or further studies."
