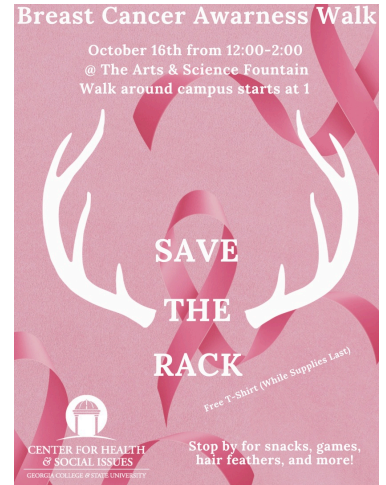

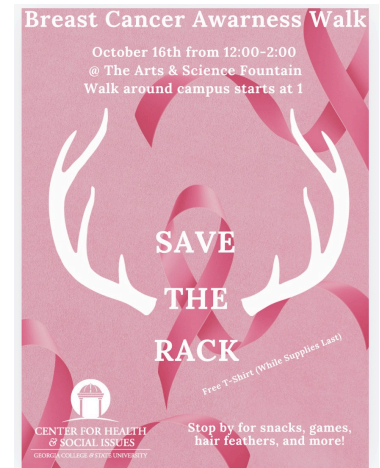

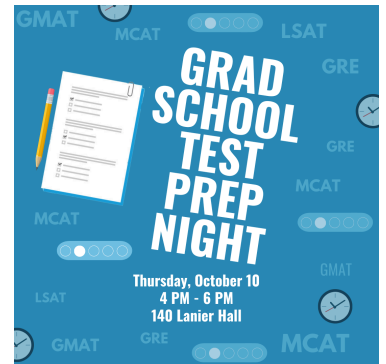

Using watercolors, charcoals, paintbrushes, easels and canvasses—students from Central Georgia will craft impromptu art during [Georgia College & State University's](#) first “Artober Celebration at [Andalusia: Home of Flannery O’Connor.](#)”



It'll be a day of “En Plein Air” painting 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 5. The term refers to artists leaving the confinements of four walls for an open-air experience. Rain or shine, students from Georgia College and other local schools like Mercer University and Wesleyan College will gather outdoors to paint the landscapes of Andalusia.

“Set up your easel wherever inspiration strikes, whether it’s under the shade of the ancient oaks, beside the tranquil pond or near the charming farmhouse,” said Matthew Forrest, interim chair of GCSU’s [Department of Art](#). “Connect with fellow artists and enthusiasts in a supportive and creative environment.”

The public is invited to watch art-in-the-making and enjoy access to the Andalusia Interpretive Center and grounds. For a small fee, tours will be conducted of the [farmhouse](#) where the popular Southern writer and GCSU alumna lived.

While creating artwork, students will interact with community members.

Completed paintings will be displayed in Georgia College’s [Underwood House Gallery](#), 102 South Columbia St. in Milledgeville. The exhibit begins Wednesday, Oct. 10, and runs through Oct. 30. An Arttober artists’ celebration will be 5 to 7 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 30.

Gallery hours are 1 to 4 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays, and the exhibit is free.

“This is the first event of its kind for the university,” said Megan McNaught, gallery director and [museum studies](#) lecturer. “It’s a wonderful way to watch landscape painting while enjoying the Andalusia grounds. Come learn about the life and legacy of Flannery O’Connor, an important piece of Milledgeville history.”

# Cormac McCarthy and Flannery O'Connor: Links, Likeness, Legacy

O'Connor Institute : Monday October 21, 2024

This talk by scholar-in-residence, Dr. Farrell O'Gorman, will detail how Cormac McCarthy (1933-2023), one of the most acclaimed American novelists of the last 50 years, is inextricably linked to Flannery O'Connor. He repeatedly praised her in the early years of his career—most substantially in his correspondence with Robert Coles, an influential Harvard child psychiatrist who wrote extensively on O'Connor while also acting as a patron to McCarthy. In his fiction, McCarthy, like O'Connor, continually addressed certain recurrent philosophical and religious questions (e.g., regarding gnosticism) that are essential to understanding the two of them as not only Southern Gothic but American Gothic authors. Finally, their legacies have frequently overlapped in critically acclaimed films from the 1970s to the present, perhaps most complexly in the Oscar-winning Coen brothers film "No Country for Old Men" (2007).

Farrell O'Gorman is Professor of English at Belmont Abbey College and taught previously at Mississippi State University and DePaul University. He is the author of two monographs: "Peculiar Crossroads: Flannery O'Connor, Walker Percy and Catholic Vision in Postwar Southern Fiction" (2004) and "Catholicism and American Borders in the Gothic Literary Imagination" (2017). He has spoken on O'Connor at a variety of regional and national events, conferences in France and Italy and the 2014 O'Connor conference in Ireland, for which he served on the organizing committee. O'Gorman is a scholar-in-residence at Georgia College & State University for fall 2024.

# New GCSU Mobile Health Unit Launches TODAY, providing medical services to rural communities throughout Central Georgia

Center for Health & Social Issues : Tuesday October 22, 2024

One year after Georgia was ranked No. 7 in the nation for the [most rural hospital closings](#), [Georgia College & State University](#) will unveil its new Mobile Health Unit — a free screening center on wheels — that will address rural healthcare needs throughout the state, while providing students with invaluable experience administering preventive care services to underserved communities.



Tours of the 40-foot unit, which include two intake areas, two exam rooms, vaccination storage and more will be available at the ribbon-cutting event.

“Our new, state-of-the-art Mobile Health Unit will address a critical need for residents in rural communities — many of which are losing access to healthcare — while simultaneously providing nursing and public health students with the vital training they need to become future healthcare leaders and frontline workers,” said [GCSU President](#) Cathy Cox. “It is truly a win-win for all involved.”

[Nursing](#), [public health](#) and [exercise science](#) students will work inside the unit, supervised by faculty, to perform basic physical and mental health screenings, administer blood tests, offer vaccinations, teach CPR and assess various health metrics, according to Dr. Damian Francis, director of the university’s [Center for Health & Social Issues](#) who leads the initiative. The unit will also give students the chance to explore the social issues that drive premature disease and strain hospitals — how poverty, lack of

transportation and reduced access to insurance often lead to [obesity, elevated blood pressure, diabetes, heart disease and cancer](#), for example.

“This mobile unit will expand our reach, promote wellbeing and help us get more students out in the field to educate people about health,” said Dr. Will Evans, dean of GCSU’s [College of Health Sciences](#). “The screenings we do should catch health risks earlier and save lives.”

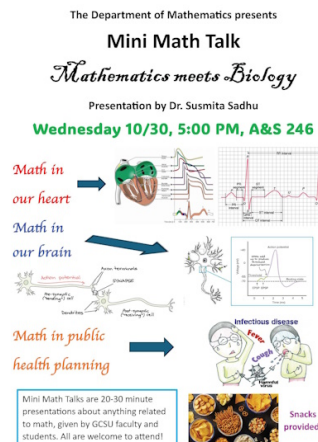

Here is the abstract of the presentation:

Mathematics has often laid the groundwork for the development of advanced methods and techniques for analyzing physiological phenomena associated with living organisms. In the last 70 years, mathematics has influenced almost all areas of biological sciences such as molecular biology, genetics, ecology, medicine, neuroscience, epidemiology and so forth. In this talk, we will discuss few examples of biological problems where mathematics has played a significant role in elucidating the basic mechanisms underlying the system, finding scaling laws of observed patterns among many living organisms and making informed health policy decisions.

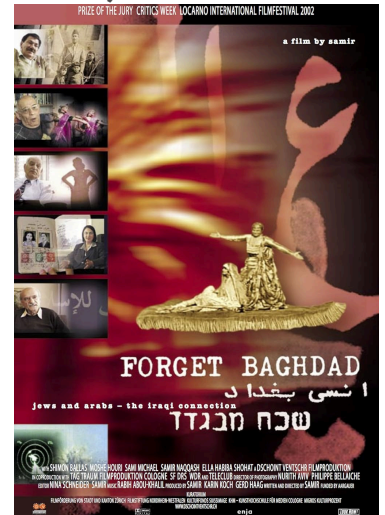

His memoir, *The Inventors*, won the 2017 Housatonic Book Award. His recent novel, *Duplicity*, won the 2021 Best Indie Book Award and the 2021 Indie Excellence Book Award. His full-length drama, *A God in the House*, based on Dr. Jack Kevorkian and his "suicide machine," won the Eugene O'Neill National Playwrights Conference Award and was most recently produced by the Town & Gown Players in Athens, Georgia. A visual artist, as well as a writer, Selgin's paintings and illustrations have been featured in *The New Yorker*, *Forbes*, *Gourmet* and other publications. His cover designs appear on many award-winning books. He is professor of Creative Writing at Georgia College & State University, where he is art director and nonfiction editor of *Arts & Letters*, an international journal of poetry and prose.

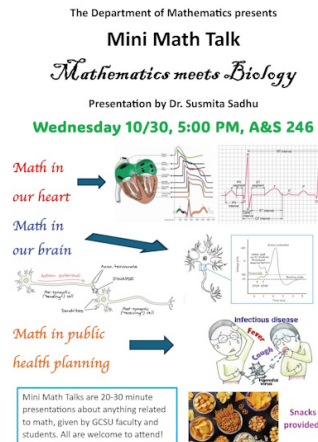



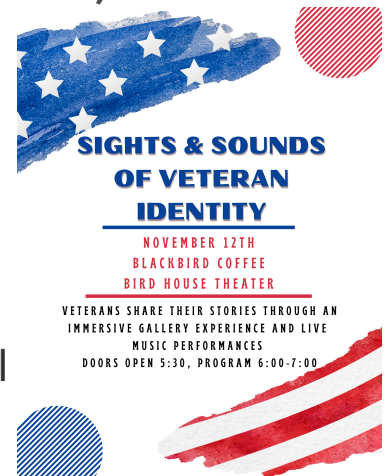
