## Biographies



**Stephen Hoy** has been playing the trombone for over fifty years. During high school and college, he studied with Dr. James Thurmond, the first director/conductor of the Navy School of Music. Upon graduating from Lebanon Valley College in 1977 he enlisted in the USAF as a trombonist. His assignments included Robins AFB in Warner Robins, GA and Keesler AFB in Biloxi, MS. After separating from the USAF Stephen became a music educator in Warner Robins and eventually earned a M.M. in Trombone Performance in 2009 from Mercer University. He currently serves as Adjunct

Professor of Low Brass at Georgia College and State University. Stephen has performed with the Southeast Trombone Symposium Professor's Choir, the Ocmulgee Symphony, the Albany Symphony, the Macon Symphony, The Temptations, Sarah McLachlan, and jazz trombonists Urbie Green, Rob McConnell, Slide Hampton, and Bill Watrous. He currently performs with the Georgia Big Band, Wellston Winds, and with trombone quartet Slide Effects.



**Riley Greer** is a junior music major at Georgia College & State University from Thomaston, Georgia. She aspires to earn her master's degree in education and continue her education in performance and conducting. Praised for her expression and musical interpretation, Riley is a two-time NATS finalist, a three-time GC&SU music scholarship recipient, and the 2023 Concerto Competition winner. She is an avid member of Sigma Alpha Iota and serves as Vice President of Membership and serves on the Collegiate National Association for Music Educators leadership council at GC&SU.

## *About the John and Margaret Terry Endowed Concert Series...*

John and Margaret Terry both descended from distinguished New England families. John was an engineer who received his education at the University of New Haven in Connecticut. An accomplished sailor and veteran, his love of the sea was only surpassed by his love of music. His sailing voyages even took him to South America, which was considered a daunting passage by 1950s standards. He had a marvelously dry sense of humor and was an amazing punster.

Margaret was an executive secretary to the president of a worldwide corporation. A proud graduate of the Laurelton Hall preparatory school, she was an elegant woman whose refinement and sophisticated taste complemented and enhanced John's adventures through the Americas, the rivers of Europe, and the Caribbean.

John and Margaret's passion for music was lifelong. As world travelers, their taste in music was wide ranging. They were steadfast supporters of the arts. As season ticket holders for numerous venues, they often hosted many of their friends so that they could share their enthusiasm for the arts. Their legacy, to those who knew them, was that the human spirit is enriched when transported by the beauty of music.

The Gorzelany family established the John and Margaret Terry Endowed Concert Series at Georgia College to honor this legacy. We hope that the lives of Georgia College students and the greater Milledgeville community are enriched, inspired, and uplifted by biennial performances of the greatest works from the classical repertoire.
