Steven Taylor is presently the cello instructor at GCSU. He studied with Harvey Shapiro at The Juilliard School where he earned bachelor and master degrees in music and was a recipient of the Eva Shapiro Memorial Scholarship. He has appeared as a soloist with the Toledo Symphony, Little Orchestra Society of Toledo, Brevard Music Center Orchestra, Savannah Symphony, and the Valdosta Symphony. He performed the American premier of Johan de Meij's "Casanova" in 2001 and the world Premier of Arthur Rodriguez "Elegy and Rondo" in 2009 with the Valdosta State University Wind Ensemble. Before teaching at GCSU he was the principal cellist of the Valdosta Symphony Orchestra, the cellist of the Azalea String Quartet, and cello instructor at Valdosta State University.
