About our Guest Composers

We are delighted to welcome back composers **Raphael Fusco** and **David Hamilton**. Fresh from his residency last fall, Fusco returns with the world premiere of “Firefly,” written for treble voices and harp—further evidence of how he has added to the repertoire for treble voices. Hamilton—whose most recent residency with us was in 2023—offers “Dance-Song to the Creator” for piano four hands and percussion, the first multiple-ensemble Hamilton work we performed (Fall 2013). Our collaboration with Hamilton has also included commissions and premieres of “Dona Nobis Pacem,” written in memory of the victims of the Sandy Hook shooting, and “Whakarongo mai,” conceived to culminate a global choral program planned for 2020 and premiered in 2023 due to COVID. We are grateful for these fruitful, artistic partnerships and for our continued collaboration with internationally recognized, award-winning composers.
