- Georgia State University in Atlanta announced that they have inducted 27 students into The 1913 Society, named for the year when the university was found. The 1913 Society serves as hosts for high-profile events and ceremonies. Among the 27 were the following local students - Kiniya Glenn of Atlanta; and Braden Mazna, Bryson Turner and Kylie Escobido, all of Marietta.
- The 2025-26 University of North Georgia Alumni Student Hosts are ready to perform their duties during Alumni Weekend, April 17-19, at UNG's Dahlonega campus and additional Dahlonega spots. Local hosts include Cleo Johnson of Kennesaw and Halle Enge of Marietta.
- Breeana McLean of Marietta was elected and sworn in to serve in the University of Alabama's 115th Student Government Association's Administration. The president, executive council and 49 senators representing all of UA's colleges and schools will serve the campus community through spring 2027. McLean represents the College of Human Environmental Sciences Senators.
- Love Crumby of Kennesaw was inaugurated as a Senator representing the Andrew Young School of Policy Studies in the Georgia State University Student Government Association in April 2026. The primary purpose of the SGA is to represent the students' interests to the university and serve as the official voice of students in academic, institutional and community affairs. It also appoints student representatives to the wider University Senate, giving students a voice on the central university-wide body that is key to decision making at GSU.
