STUDENTS will be Monday, March 7 through Thursday, March 10. Academic advisors will be available in the Academic Advising Center on the second floor of Lanier Hall each day at 6:45 AM for any students who need registration assistance.

POUNCE is Georgia College's program for registering new first-year students who have already paid their confirmation deposit. After opening on February 1st, 560 students have completed the POUNCE process and received Fall 2022 schedules from their academic advisors. We anticipate at least 940 more POUNCE requests as the Admissions Office nears our 1,500 new first-year student target.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Academic Advising Center has added a new drop-in service for students who have general advising questions; need assistance with pre-registration worksheets; or need help using PAWS, College Scheduler, or DegreeWorks. The **HELP HUB** is located in the Academic Advising Center on the second floor of Lanier Hall, is open 8 a.m. - 5 p.m., Monday – Friday, and is staffed by professional advisors and student interns.
