- Full time undergraduate student at GCSU
- Completed a minimum of 45 hours of community outreach with the CHSI between junior and senior year
- Have maintained an overall GPA of at least 2.7 during junior and senior year
- Submitted 100 word reflection on a CHSI community outreach event
- Completed 1 or more training in QPR, CPR, BLS, ACLS, AED, First Aid
- Academic reference (name and email of professor)
