#### **CRASE – Civilian Response to Active Shooter Event**

The CRASE course was designed and built on the Avoid, Deny, and Defend strategy developed by ALERRT in 2004. The course provides strategies, guidance, and a proven plan for surviving an active shooter event. Topics include the history and prevalence of active shooter events, the role of professional guardians, civilian response options, medical issues, and drills.
