Her short works about history, true crime, and horror have appeared in *Oxford American*, *Narratively*, *Mental Floss*, and *FANGORIA*, among other publications. She hosts and co-writes *The Greatest True Crime Stories Ever Told*, a podcast about women in true crime who are not just victims, and co-hosts *Everything Trying to Kill You*, a comedy podcast that analyzes horror movies from the perspectives of women of color.

Garrett Curbow is the author of *Whispers of Ink and Starlight* (2026) and the *Daughter of Light* trilogy, which was short-listed for the Publishers Weekly Selfies Award. A graduate of the BA creative writing program at Georgia College & State University, he is represented by Brent Taylor at Triada US. He lives in Savannah, Georgia.
